• Pinot Noir/Chardonnay - fresh and vivacious, a fruit salad of raspberry, red currant & strawberry. Very fine bubbles.
- 3 MARGALLEAU, VOUVRAY, BRUT, LOIRE VALLEY '13 11 / 44
• Chenin Blanc - Dry and crisp with hints of warm honey, lemon, white flowers, and graham cracker.
- 5 ERIC BORDELET, "GRANIT," POIRE, NORMANDY '14 48
• Pear Cider - off dry, fresh, clean, great summer sparkling cider, low alcohol

• Chardonnay - Ripe citrus and peach, exuberant bubbles give creamy texture. 90 pts WS

• 40% Chardonnay/50% Pinot Noir /10% Pinot Meunier - A richness of fruits-mulberry and blackcurrant, peach- a note of cocoa, making a round, supple, velvety wine. A beautiful silky texture, sustained by a tender effervescence.

• Chardonnay - Fresh and dynamic, aromatics, layers of crisp apples, pears, spices and flowers. 91 pts WS / WA

• Sauvignon Blanc - Medium bodied with citrus fruit and pineapple notes with vibrant acidity mineral finish.

• Chasselas - Bright & subtle. Medium - full body, nutty with light stone fruit mellow acid. Slightly mineral finish. 90 pts WA

• Pinot Noir - Light, elegant and smooth, fruit of red berries. Mild tannins and acidity.

• 50% Grenache /45% Cinsault /5% Syrah - Aromas of red currants, fresh nuts, rose and minerality. Fresh, well balanced with good acidity.

• Pinot Noir - red cherry, pomegranate, velvety smooth, light body.
- 210 LES CHAMPS DE THEMIS "LES BOSEBUTS", MERCUREY '16 70
• Pinot Noir - Try to find this somewhere else, we dare you. Limited production and distribution make this our little diamond in the rough. As with most Mercurey this is on the masculine side with ripe red fruits and some weight but still has that focused acidity that Burgundy is known for.

• Pinot Noir - Fresh ripe cherry and strawberry. Subtle minerality and tannins. Smooth, medium body.
- 56 MONTHELIE DOUHAIRET PORCHERET, "LES DURESSSES," MONTHELIE 1ER CRU, '15 110
• Pinot Noir - Colorful with accents of cherry, strawberry, gooseberry, and raspberry.
- 57 DOMAINE CHARLES AUDOIN, "LE ROZIER", FIXIN '14 90
• Pinot Noir - Aromatic expression of black fruit, enhanced by mushrooms, spices and leather in the background.
- 59 LA FOLLETTE "SANGIACOMO VINEYARD" SONOMA COAST '14 87
• Pinot Noir - Raspberries, bark and stone introduce a balance wine with red fruits and lychee on palate. 92 pts WS
- 60 DOMAINE CAMUS-BRUCHON, BOURGOGNE '16 15 / 29 / 60
• Pinot Noir - Rich spice and dark fruits on the nose. Notes of chocolate, raspberry, strawberry, black pepper and toasted oak. Medium body with long finish.

• Gamay - Hand harvested and aged in stainless steel, this light bodied well balanced wine is full of red fruit with a hint of spice & chocolate. Enjoy with charcuterie. 100% family run winery, from farming to sales.
- 49 DOMAINE EMILE CHEYSSON "CLOS LES FARGES" CHIROUBLES, BEAUJOLAIS '15 48
• Gamay - Made from the highest altitude Cru Beaujolais village with soil of crushed granite. Palate of red berries and a pinch of soil, lively acidity and sleek tannins, this is a great easy to drink wine.

- 61 BERNARD BAUDRY, "LE CLOS GUILLOT" CHINON, LOIRE VALLEY '14 68
• Cabernet Franc - Refined with aromas of sour cherries and black fruit. Spicy Chinon, layering green peppercorn and green bell pepper notes, a hint of balsamic.
- 68 GEORGES VIGOUROUX, CHATEAU LAFLEUR DE HAUTE SERRE, CAHORS '15 45
• 90% Malbec / 10% Merlot - Earthy, elegant and feminine. Silky tannins Dark fruit and truffle goes wonderfully with meats and charcuterie.
- 118 CHÂTEAU DU PARC, SAINT-ÉMILION GRAND CRU, BORDEAUX '14 90
• 90% Merlot / 10% Cab. Franc - Very ripe, red fruit notes on the nose contrasted by spicy notes with beautiful complexity. On the palate, it has beautiful red fruits throughout and the spicy tannins are very integrated.
- 117 LA RESERVE DE MALARTIC, PESSAC-LEOGNAN, BORDEAUX '15 85
• 65% Merlot / 30% Cabernet / 5% Cab. Franc - Meant to be enjoyed at a younger age and drinkable NOW. Big, bold, black-fruited, with just enough oak, this is a crowd pleaser.
- 63 CHATEAU SAINT AUBIN, MEDOC, BORDEAUX '15 15 / 29 / 60
• Bordeaux Blend - From vineyards in the furthest Northern area of Bordeaux, full of black fruits, toasty and dry.
- 64 CHATEAU MEYNEY, ST-ESTÈPHE BORDEAUX '15 84
• Bordeaux blend - Fruity, floral and spicy bouquet, powerful and rich. The creamy mid-mouthful echoes the intense bouquet of wine and confirms a big aromatic complexity.

• 40% Cabernet/25% Merlot/23% Cab Franc/12% P. Verdot - Second wine of Kriwan. Round and fleshy with powerful fruit flavors of black currant and plum. Balanced acidity and fruit with just a hint of oak.

• Cabernet/Merlot/Cab Franc/Petit Verdot - Second wine of Château Boyd-Cantenac. Floral notes with dark red fruits. Subtlety, complexity, intense and elegance.

• 83%Grenache/12% Syrah/5%Cinsault - Well structured with intense bouquet of crushed strawberries and blueberries with a hint of licorice. Pairs well with venison.
- 72 **DOMAINE LE GRAND RETOUR, CÔTES DU RHÔNE VILLAGES '15** 12 / 23 / 48
• Gernache/Syrah/Mourvedre - Red berry, fruit and spices. Leather, aniseed, and liquorice.
- 73 **DOMAINE LES PALLIERES, GIGONDAS "LES RACINES", RHONE '15** 80
• 80% Grenache / 15% Syrah - Cinsault (co-planted) / 5% Clairette - Deep rich and aromatic, black cherry & dried herb, ripe tannins terrific length 92 pts WS
- 74 **ANDRE BRUNEL, CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, RHONE '16** 86
• Rhone Blend - Rich and luxurious flavors, sweet silky tannins. Slightly lighter body than 2015, Don't let the age fool you, delicious now.
- 75 **DOMAINE CHANTE CIGALE, CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, RHONE '15 / 375 ML** 54
• 65% Grenache / 20% Syrah / 10% Mourvedre / 5% Cinsault - Creamy tannins, raspberry and cherry fruit, and a dusting of cinnamon and allspice on the long, dusty finish. 94 pts RP
- 205 **DOMAINE GAYLORD MACHON "LHONY", CROZES-HERMITAGE '14** 70
• Syrah - Appealing raspberry liqueur, some oak and a note of damp forest on the nose. The palate bears clove, spicing, appealing fruit within, red fruits and raspberry. It's a very sound wine in a mighty tricky year.
- 201 **LIONEL FAURY, CÔTE RÔTIE '16** 135
• 90% Syrah/10% Viognier - Its depth on the palate, along with the never-ending aromas of eucalyptus, menthol, game, leather, violets, spice, suggests a Côte-Rôtie of the old school. Perfect pairing for the steak frites.
- 82 **DOMAINE PETRONI, CORSE ROUGE, CORSICA '15** 45
• 50% Niellucciu (Sangiovese), 35% Syrah, and 15% Grenache - Vibrant dark berry, tiny hints of fresh tobacco and evergreen. The palate is medium and wonderfully lifted. Super juicy length and clean. A fun easy drinking wine. 90 pts

- 92 **OBSIDIAN RIDGE, RED HILLS LAKE COUNTY '16** 65
• Cabernet Sauvignon - Dark aromas of ripe blackberries and black currants melled with spicy cloves and anise. Hints of cacao beans and dark chocolate nibs. Full bodied with a core of black fruit compote, medium tannins.
- 94 **BELLA VINEYARD, DRY CREEK VALLEY '16** 14 / 27 / 56
• Zinfandel - On the palate, juicy flavors of blackberry and black cherry are underscored by an enticing spiciness that lingers on the elegant finish.
- 93 **DAY, EL DIABLO VINEYARD, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, '15** 98
• Zinfandel - Exotic, intense, ripe with superb depth. Inky dark cherry,menthol, lavender and rose petal nuances. 93 pts Vinous
- 95 **BONNY DOON VINEYARD, "LE POUSSEUR", CENTRAL COAST, CA '13** 15 / 29 / 60
• Syrah - Love Cabernet? - Treat yourself & give this gem a try. Perfumed & full bodied with notes of raspberry, cherry, lilac, white and black pepper, savory herbs and bacon. 93 pts
- 91 **SCHOLIUM PROJECT, BABYLON, TENBRICK VINEYARD, SUISUN VALLEY, '12** 86
• Petite Sirah - Filled with ripe, rich fruit and a plethora of spices. Rich and intense red wine. 92 pts

RÊVE RESERVES

- 4 DOMAINE CARNEROS, BY TATTINGER "LE REVE" BLANC DE BLANC '08** 150
• Chardonnay - I mean it's called La Reve, do you need any more convincing it belongs on this list? The wine showcases an array of toasty notes reminiscent of brioche, toasted almond and even creme brulee, interwoven with these notes are white flowers, citrus and pear. Very full and round palate. Treat yourself, drink up our namesake.
- 80 CHATEAU DE FONSALETTE "RESERVE" COTES DU RHONE '06** 210
• Syrah / Cinsault / Grenache blend - Pop and pour NOW, as this beauty has just entered the drink me phase of it's life. Fonsalette is widely regarded as one of the top producers in the Rhone Valley. There's that lovely nose of ripe raspberry and incense, but some meaty syrah notes as well, with some cola and blackberry. On the palate, nice texture, some sweetness from the ripe fruit and a nice black raspberry and a hint of bitter black fruit. Like a tenured fine dining waiter, the tannins are perfectly integrated so you know they're there but you hardly notice them.
- 17 DOMAINE DU CHÂTEAU DE PULIGNY-MONTRACHET, PULIGNY-MONTRACHET '15** 152
• Chardonnay - One of only a few Domaine named after the place it's from, this has the complexity one is looking for in quality White Burg. Their wines are known for their great aromatic purity, favoring balance and elegance over power and extraction (as it should be). They're classic expressions of Burgundy, of their appellations in general and of their specific terroirs. The limestone soil is moderately deep and the appellation benefits from early harvesting in order to fully maintain its freshness.
- 15 DOMAINE DE MONTILLE, LES NARVAUX-DESSOUS, MEURSAULT '15** 170
• Chardonnay - The vineyard Les Narvaux du Dessous was acquired by the Domaine in 2008. It faces southeast, rather high on the Meursault slope. The soil is deep and very rocky. Narvaux typically offers a beautiful combination of the suppleness and generosity typical of the appellation held back by a lovely minerality. This is a serious wine for the refined Burgundy palate.
- 116 CLOS SOLENE "FLEUR DE SOLENE", PASO ROBLES, CA '14** 130
• 70% Syrah/20% Grenache/10% Cabernet Franc - See above for the story on this producer we can tell you about what's in the bottle. Open it early as it needs a bit of time to unwind, but once it does, it's another ode to balanced richness. Aromas of blackberry and wet slate lead into an elegant palate that's thick, soft and full of grippy tannins. Flavors of elderberry and violet lead into a polished vanilla finish.
- 111 CLOS SOLENE, "HOMMAGE BLANC", PASO ROBLES, CA '16** 120
• 75% Roussanne/25% Viognier - Clos Solene is a story near and dear to Reve Bistro. Boy (Guillame Fabre) meets girl (Solene), falls in love, they uproot their lives and they settle into their shared dream. A winery in Paso Robles in their case, a restaurant in Lafayette in Paul & Laura's case. So featuring Clos Solene was a no brainer. The story is great and the wine is just as good. The palate is both tropical and extremely fresh, with pear flesh and light guava flavors wrapped up in a bountiful acid and grippy texture.
- 67 CHATEAU BONALGUE, POMEROL, BORDEAUX '15** 130
• 90% Merlot/10% Cab Franc - The property traces its history back to before the French Revolution with the current owner having purchased the chateau in 1926. Château Bonalgue sits in the very west of Pomerol just near the Libourne city limit. The property only has about 7.5 hectares of vines that are planted mostly to Merlot. Big and rich with plum, dried fruit and stone aromas and flavors. Full body, round and velvety tannins with a chewy finish. Tons of volume and weight just dying for a little (or a lot of) red meat.
- 115 CHATEAU BEYCHEVELLE "AMIRAL DE BEYCHEVELLE" ST-JULIEN, BORDEAUX '16** 140
• Bordeaux Blend - The 2nd wine of Chateau Beychevelle, it's namesake is the French Admiral Jean-Louis Nogaret de la Valette, the 2nd owner of Château Beychevelle. The Admiral was so revered that ships would lower their sails as they passed his estate as a gesture of respect. Thus, the origin of the Château's name, Beychevelle, which is derived from the Gascogne phrase "Bêcha vêla" or "baisse voile" (lower the sails). A message in a bottle with salty, oceanic aromatics, followed by a treasure trove of dark red fruits. Medium body, forward and approachable with a soft, refined, fruity finish. Ahoy!
- 203 CHATEAU LATOUR, PAUILLAC, BORDEAUX '85** 495
• Bordeaux Blend - One of only 5 1st Growth Bordeaux Chateau so no need for a long, drawn out introduction. This is FINALLY ready to drink. 34 years and it's ready to be enjoyed. Full velvety texture with fresh and clean fruit. Sure, there's some bottle age but this is still holding strong.
- 202 CHATEAU L'EVANGILE, POMEROL, BORDEAUX '98** 200
• Right in the middle of its sweet spot and is drinking fantastically. Pencil shavings and cedar. Lovely sweet fruit, a wine that grabs your attention from the very first whiff and keeps you spellbound to the very last drop. A stunning example of the Pomerol 1998 vintage.
- 97 CHAPPELLET, "SIGNATURE" NAPA VALLEY '16** 140
• 79% Cabernet/12% Petit Verdot /9% Malbec - The Signature has been Chappellet's flagship wine for more than three decades. It's a benchmark for the long-lived hillside wines of the Napa Valley. Deep, rich and beautifully structured, this is absolutely classic hillside Napa Valley Cab, offering aromas of blackberry, cassis, and chocolate, along with hints of espresso, anise and fragrant herbs. Concentrated berry and black cherry flavors are underscored by velvety tannins and subtle notes of cola and clove.
- 204 HOURGLASS, ESTATE, NAPA VALLEY '15** 190
• 100% Cabernet Sauvignon - If you're looking for a slap you in the face with fruit and oak Napa Cab, I give you Hourglass. Now, there's some refinement here as well. The front end is all fruit and power but it finishes nicely without being overpowering. The length of this wine really stands out. Hello, Ribeye, you there?

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
